10 amazing schools in Poland:

Szkoła Podstawowa in Brojce

The primary school in Brojce was opened in September 1945. Its seat was located in the building of the former German school. In 1960, a new school building was built next to the old one. In 1997, new parts of the building were built. Since 1999, a secondary school in Brojce was located on its first floor, while the ground floor was occupied by the Primary School and the school office. Currently, the entire building is occupied by a primary school with a kindergarten, There are: classrooms, a library, a computer lab, a gym and a canteen, which also serves as a training room. There are a total of 249 students, including 76 preschoolers. The proper functioning of the school is ensured by the school management, who cares not only about the well-being of students, but also teachers. The students also do a lot for themselves and the local community, for example helping children in Africa. The school participates in various projects, thanks to which students could go on trips and participate in interesting activities. The school received additional equipment for classrooms, multimedia boards and computer equipment. There's a lot going on here: students participate in competitions, actions organized by schools and other institutions, they can develop their interests in extracurricular activities, interesting people visit us and talk about for example, children's rights, trips are organized, e.g. to Krakow, or camping by the sea. In November 2022, the fourth charity concert took place, this time for a sick student from our school. The Student Council is also very active, who listen to the needs of their peers and implement their suggestions as far as possible. The activities of the student council and the school can be followed on Facebook under the name SU Brojce. Recently, a kitten lived at school, which everyone took care of it. It was sad when someone finally found him. On the other hand, there was joy that the kitten gained a real home and people who would take care of it.

Obecnie cały budynek zajmuje szkoła podstawowa wraz z przedszkolem, w którym są:lekcyjne, biblioteka, pracownia komputerowa, sala gimnastyczna i stołówka, która pełni także funkcję świetlicy szkolnej.

Łącznie jest 249 uczniów, w tym 76 przedszkolaków. O właściwe funkcjonowanie szkoły dba dyrekcja szkoły, której zależy nie tylko na dobrym samopoczuciu uczniów, ale i nauczycieli.

Uczniowie także wiele robią dla siebie i społeczności lokalnej, a nawet działania wolontariatu sięgają dalej,np.: pomagają dzieciom w Afryce.







